Trees in the Bible

The Lord must love trees, because they are mentioned a lot in the Bible. We know they're important for oxygen and the food found on many of them, but let's learn more about trees from a Biblical lens.

Starting off with creation week, in Genesis 1:11-12, we're told that God created trees and saw they were good. What a wonderful gift He gave us in trees. In Psalm 1: 2-4, those who love the law of the Lord are compared to trees planted along the riverbank with leaves that never wither. Jeremiah 17:7-8 tells us something very similar, stating that the man who trusts the Lord is blessed and will be like a tree, planted with good roots. In Isaiah 55:12, we're given a beautiful picture of trees worshiping their creator by clapping their hands. I envision a group of trees with golden leaves swaying in a wind sent by the Lord. Jesus even calls Himself a type of tree when He says in John 15:5 that He is the vine.

Take a few minutes to look up each scripture mentioned above. You can also look up more scriptures mentioning trees - there are many!


